



PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Quality ingredients prepared in pelleted form.

PURPOSE

- GOAT BREEDER PELLETS PLUS RUMENSIN are suitable for feeding to lactating MEAT goats and growing goats from 10 weeks to 5 months of age.

COMPOSITION

- Base grain as depicted seasonally, and therefore proportions may vary.
- Barley, wheat, maize, sorghum, bran, pollard, urea, cottonseed meal, molasses, vegetable oil, limestone, sodium bentonite, dicalcium phosphate, ammonium sulphate, salt, Rumensin™, Riverina Vitamin and Mineral Ruminant pak.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Designed to be fed in conjunction with hay and/or pasture.
- Roughage supplied should be supplied adlib.
- Ensure that there is ample access to clean water.
- Introduce goats to the ration gradually over a 2-3 week period.

Goat Age or Production State	Feed Type	Approximated Feed Intake
Birth To Three (3) Months	Kid Creep	Up to 350 grams per day in conjunction with whole milk and roughage
Three (3) To Five (5) Months	Goat Breeder Pellets plus Rumensin	Up to 500 grams per day in conjunction with pasture, cereal chaff or hay.
Five (5) Months to Mating	Goat Grower Plus Rumensin	Up to 1-1.5 kg per day depending on body weight. In conjunction with pasture, chaff or hay.
Lactating Does (Dairy Goats)	Goat Pellets	Up to 2.50kg per day according to production. Feed in conjunction with good quality pasture, chaff or hay
Breeding Angora, Cashmere	Goat Breeder or Goat Pellets	600 grams to 1.0 kg depending on bodyweight. Feed in conjunction with pasture, chaff or hay
Breeding Bucks & Maintenance	Goat Grower plus Rumensin	Up to 1.0kg per day during breeding season. Feed in conjunction with pasture, chaff and hay

- Rumensin™ as Monensin sodium added at the rate of 20 mg/kg.
